**Elmhurst Resident to Receive Board of Governors
Award from Illinois State Bar Association**

Attorney Karen McNulty Enright, a resident of **Elmhurst**, will receive the 2009 Board of Governors Award from the Illinois State Bar Association (ISBA) on Friday, June 26, at the organization's 133rd Annual Meeting in Fontana, Wis.

The award is given to ISBA members for significant service to the profession and the public.

Enright, a partner in the Chicago law firm of Winters Enright Salzetta & O'Brien, LLC, is a past president of the Women's Bar Association of Illinois. She was nominated by ISBA President Jack C. Carey for her significant contributions to the organized bar.

In his nomination letter, Carey wrote that Enright has "accepted primary responsibility for important initiatives" of the Committee on Legislation, and that she has been a member of the Committee on Amicus since its inception. She served on the Tort Law Section Council from 1998 to 2006.
