Annual Meeting Registration. *Registration is ONLINE ONLY.* Please register online at WWW.ISBA.ORG/ANNUAL. The deadline for advance registration is June 8. Visa, MasterCard, Discover and American Express all accepted.

Annual Meeting Registration Fee. The registration fee for Annual Meeting is \$70 per ISBA member and \$45 per spouse/guest. The registration fee must be paid by anyone participating in Annual Meeting functions. Registered participants are invited to any complimentary event.

Ticketed Functions (Non-CLE). Annual Meeting functions are priced as follows (per ticket): Law Office Management Breakfast/Symposium (\$25); Awards Luncheon (\$30); Kids Day Camp (\$50 per kid); Kids' Night Out (\$45 first kid, \$40 each additional within the same family); Annual Dinner (\$100); 17th Annual Networking Breakfast (\$25); and Breakfast for Families (\$15 adult/ \$5 child.)
