1. Applicant Reservation Form (Included)
2. Application for Admission to Practice (Included)
3. Certificate of Good Standing (Sample Included)
4. Full Payment of Application Fee and Applicable Event Fees

To prepare your application please follow these directions:

1. Type your Supreme Court of the United States Application for Admission to Practice.
2. DO NOT complete the section titled Motion of Admission. Completing this section will result in your having to resubmit the Sup
3. Obtain the signature of two sponsors who have already been admitted to the Supreme Court of the United States and are not related to you. Original Sponsor signatures must be on the same form, page 2 of the application.
4. Obtain the appropriate Certificate of Admission to the Bar of Illinois from the Clerk of the Supreme Court of Illinois, 217-782-2035, confirming you have been a member of the bar of our jurisdiction for at least three years and are in good standing.
5. Submit all documents with a check payable to the "Illinois State Bar Association" or credit card information for the total of the application fee of \$200.00, plus the Sunday night reception and Monday breakfast fees, Paperclip the documents and check together. PLEASE DO NOT STAPLE.
6. Note: Alternate Certificate if box checked omits language on the Certificate "in the year of our Lord".
7. Send completed Application Packet to Illinois State Bar Association, Attention: Kimberly Weaver, 424 South Second Street, Springfield, Illinois 62701 no later than March 16, 2018.

Please note:

To qualify for admission, you must have been admitted for a period of at least three years immediately before the date of application and must not have been the subject of any adverse disciplinary action pronounced or in effect during that 3-year period. If during this three year period, the application and all information pertaining to the disciplinary action must be submitted to me immediately to be sent early to the Supreme Court for consideration of approval for admission.

As the designated agent for the ISBA group, I am required to remit the applications to the U.S. Supreme Court as a group. Do not mail your application to the U. S. Supreme Court directly.

Please Note: Children under six may not be admitted to the Courtroom. They may attend the breakfast in the conference room of the Supreme Court building, but will remain in the conference room when the Court has convened. They must have an adult remain with them.

The number of guests in the Courtroom is limited to one per applicant.

Willard InterContinental Hotel Reservations must be made by the ISBA for the group room rate to apply. Please do not call the hotel directly.

The first 50 completed applications received will be on the confirmed list.
