1. Number of bills reviewed: 88
2. Significant legislation:
 - a. House Bill 4472 - Requires drivers with out-of-state registration to be covered by a liability policy and have proof of insurance
 - b. Senate Bill 2953 - Prohibits "non-original equipment manufacturer aftermarket crash parts" from inclusion in repair estimates
